NIR Seminar via Zoom: Concurrent Liability in Contract and Intellectual Property Law

May a licensor choose to base her claims against the licensee on either contract law or intellectual property law when a licensing agreement is breached? Does the answer to this question change depending on which IP right is at issue in the dispute? To what extent are these and related issues regulated by EU law?

These questions are the subject of a webinar organized by the Nordic Intellectual Property Law Review (Nordiskt Immateriellt Rättsskydd, NIR), on **Friday 27 November, from 12:00 to 13:00 (CET)**. Speaking at the webinar will be Professors Thomas Riis and Jens Schovsbo from the Centre for Information and Innovation Law at the University of Copenhagen. Their presentation draws on three new articles, published in NIR and in GRUR Int., in which they analyze recent developments in the case law of the Court of Justice of the European Union.

The webinar is free of charge and is the first in a series hosted by NIR on current and emerging issues in the field of intellectual property law.
